

Is Benin a country?

Benin's former name, until 1975, was Dahomey. Benin has a population of 10 million people (in 2013), Porto-Novo, a port on an inlet of the Gulf of Guinea is the nation's capital city, largest city and economic capital is Cotonou. Spoken languages are French (official), Fon and Yoruba.

Where is the government based in Benin?

Cotonou is the seat of government. Benin (officially called the Republic of Benin) is a country in Africa. The capital of Benin is Porto-Novo. The government is based in Cotonou, the country's largest city. Most people live on the small southern coastline on the Bight of Benin.

Is Benin a Marxist state?

A self-described Marxist-Leninist state called the People's Republic of Benin existed between 1975 and 1990. In 1991, it was replaced by the multi-party Republic of Benin. The official language of Benin is French, with indigenous languages such as Fon, Bariba, Yoruba and Dendi also spoken.

Why was Benin renamed Benin?

On 30 November 1975, following a Marxist-Leninist military coup, the country was renamed Benin, after the Bight of Benin, which borders the country, due to Dahomey only being associated with the Fon who inhabited the southern half of the country. The bight takes its name from the Kingdom of Benin, located in present-day Nigeria.

Is Benin a member of OHADA?

Benin is a member of the Organization for the Harmonization of Business Law in Africa (OHADA). Cotonou has the country's only seaport and international airport. Benin is connected by 2-lane asphalted roads to its neighboring countries (Togo, Burkina Faso, Niger, and Nigeria).

Is Benin a constitutional republic?

Benin is a constitutional presidential republic. In April 2021, voters re-elected Patrice Talon to a second five-year term as president in a multiparty election. Electoral code registration and sponsorship requirements precluded most opposition political parties from participating in the election.
