How do I get to Cocos (Keeling) Islands?

The Cocos (Keeling) Islands welcomes visiting yachts and provides anchorages at Direction Island. Upon arrival all yachts must contact Customs on Channel 20 VHF. Once cleared by the Customs Officer you may leave your vessel and visit the Islands.

What is Cocos (Keeling) Island known for?

The Cocos (Keeling) Islands are home to some unique species of wildlife. The Islands are also free of many pests and diseases that are found in other parts of the world. The Department of Agriculture is the border agency charged with the task of protecting the environment and human health from pest or disease incursions.

How do I send mail to Cocos (Keeling)?

Postal services to Cocos are twice weekly. Envelopes and Express Post Packages will be sent by air. Other mail, including airmail packages, will be sent via sea mail which may take up to two months for delivery. Freight to the Cocos (Keeling) Islands may be sent by air or sea.

Why are the Cocos Islands called the Keeling Islands?

The territory's dual name (official since the islands' incorporation into Australia in 1955) reflects that the islands have historically been known as either the Cocos Islands or the Keeling Islands. The territory consists of two atolls made up of 27 coral islands, of which only two - West Island and Home Island - are inhabited.
