

Is CIP building a GWh Bess project in Scotland?

Denmark-based private investor CIP has taken a final investment decision (FID) and begun construction on a 500MW/one gigawatt-hour (GWh) BESS project, Coalburn 1, in Coalburn, Scotland. The project is being developed by CIP in partnership with UK-based energy storage developer Alcemi and will be one of the largest of its kind in Europe.

Where did SSE get the Bess project?

The BESS project also includes a 150MWac solar PV facility, which is expected to be completed in August 2023. It will feature 369,334 solar photovoltaic panels covering 1,600 acres. The facility will power 26,000 homes in the region and support California's clean energy goals as the state works toward its net-zero target of

2045.

This stage will see an additional 240MW/1030MWh grid-forming BESS constructed, bringing the overall capacity to over 2GWh with the new 4-hour duration system. This complements Origin's existing 460MW/1073MWh 2-hour duration BESS currently under construction as part of stage one of the overall project.

"With Enervest, we share a focus on large-scale and financially attractive projects to enhance grid resiliency, and the Stoney Creek project is another example of executing the growth plans that we have outlined for 2025 and beyond."
