

How much power does Brazil lose a year?

Brazil, with a large and complex grid system that has not fully kept up with the demands of the energy transition, loses about 16% of the power it generates. Historically, Brazil has lacked investment in new grid infrastructure, particularly in remote areas where the potential for renewable energy development exists.

How important is Brazil's energy transition policy?

And the energy transition policy framework that we are building and implementing is also a critical aspect of Brazil's commitment in terms of decarbonizing and reducing emissions. And that is also something that we really hope to deliver as a lead by example when COP30 comes.

Will solar power be the leading source of energy in Brazil?

"And according to some long-term projections the solar energy has the potential to respond to 32% of Brazil's total capacity by 2040, which would make it the leading source of energy in Brazil ahead of hydropower". The recent growth and potential market for both solar and wind energy is also fuelling innovation.

Will wind power be the second most important source of energy in Brazil?

"The market and capacity installed will continue to grow at least for the next 15 or 20 years and in 2022 wind power should be the second most important source of energy in Brazil, behind only hydropower", says Ibia. This potential has already created a dynamic internal market and is attracting heavy-weight international players.

Will Brazil throw away the meaning of the energy transition?

Brazil could receive an estimated BRL 2 trillion in investments towards the green economy over ten years. "We are not going to throw away the meaning of the energy transition. This country has already thrown away too many opportunities. We cannot throw away opportunities. We need to bear in mind that we have everything.

How many GW of energy will Brazil have?

Together, they will represent roughly 10% of the country's total energy installed capacity, which is around 170 GW today. If explored to their full potential, Brazilian strong and steady winds alone can reach up to 500 GW of capacity.
