Potential-Induced Degradation or PID is another degradation mechanism affecting PV modules and reducing their efficiency.

Appropriate degradation rates of solar panels are estimated at 0.5% per year considering a well-maintained PV system featuring ideal conditions. However, solar panel degradation rates can reach up in some extreme cases, going as high as 1.4% or 1.54% per year.
