Are crucian carp invasive?

Crucian carp is also sensitive to competition and the closely related invasive gibel carp, *Carassius gibelio*, has become a threat to crucians. Gibel carp is not native to Europe, but has been introduced from Asia and used in aquaculture. Crucian carp has disappeared in locations where gibels are present.

Can crucian carp be harvested without draining a pond?

Crucian carp, being a bottom-dwelling fish, are difficult to harvest effectively without draining the pond. Harvesting methods include netting at a reduced water depth and total harvesting after drainage.

Is crucian carp a pond fish?
