The JRC is situated in the Lim#243;n canton, one of the most vulnerable regions with the highest poverty rate in Costa Rica. On the other hand, it is incredibly rich in biodiversity and beauty. The Jaguar Rescue Centre Community is a programme that works with local schools, government and communities to encourage cooperation and sustainability.

The Costa Rican government has implemented regulations that allow individuals and companies to produce and sell solar energy. The participation of solar energy in Costa Rica is projected to reach 1.3% by 2030.
