Can you put solar panels on a roof?

Ground-mounted systems are another alternative to fitting solar panels on your roof. Some state-of-the-art systems can rotate to follow the sun and maximise the amount of electricity they produce. This can be a good option if your roof isn't a suitable place to put a solar panel system. However, they may need foundations and can also be pricey.

Can a UK roof support solar panels?

As long as your roof is pitched, has enough unshaded space, and doesn't contain spray foam insulation underneath, it should be suitable for solar panels. The large majority of UK roofs are more than capable of supporting solar panels for as long as you need them to.

Are solar roof tiles better than solar panels?

Solar roof tiles are also around 40% less efficient than solar panels, which means your annual savings will be lower. You should only get solar tiles if you have the money to spend and don't like the look of solar panels, or if you live in a conservation area or listed building.

Can you replace roof tiles with solar panels?

You can replace your roof tiles with solar panels, either using solar roof tiles or in-roof solar panels. In both cases, the process involves removing your existing roof tiles and installing photovoltaic panels in their place. However, solar roof tiles need a complete roof replacement, while in-roof panels only replace specific sections.

What are solar roof tiles?

Solar roof tiles, also known as solar slates or solar shingles, are made to look a lot like normal roof tiles, except they also contain photovoltaic (PV) cells and can generate electricity. Unlike traditional solar panels, which sit on top of your roof, solar roof tiles are your roof, i.e. they completely replace your old tiles.
