Apps can be used for fabric calculation, quilt block design, quilt layout, stash organizing, and even chatting with quilter friends. While no quilting app will yet replace robust software like Electric Quilt 8, apps are still super handy on your phone or tablet.

What is the best fabric app for quilters?

In my opinion, based on my research and experience with each of the above fabric stash apps, I've decided the best fabric app for quilters is Stash Star Fabric. If you happen to find that there are additional features not available in Stash Star Fabric that you wish to have in a fabric app, then, by all means, choose a different app.

Downloadable for Android or iOS, Quilting Tutorials by MSQC is an app worth downloading for its high-quality quilting tutorials. It's made by Missouri Star Quilt Co. The Quiltful app helps you organize your quilting projects, so you can focus more on sewing and less on planning and organizing. With this project organizing app made just for quilters, you can organize and search for your quilting projects, track your progress and plan for the steps to do next, maintain records of quilts made, and more.

Is quiltography a good app?

It's frequently updated and is highly rated. In addition to being a quilt block designer and layout planner, you can store your fabric stash and even turn photos into pixellated quilt designs. How do you store fabric for a quilt?

Plastic tubs are the fabric storage of choice for many quilters. If you want to avoid sunlight damage, keep your stash behind closed doors. Organize fabric by color, by manufacturer, or by patterns such as polka dots and stripes. Outfit a closet for fabric storage. A wire-drawer storage rack organizes works-in-progress and precut fabrics.

Never store quilts in plastic for long periods of time. Fabric needs to breathe and the gasses produced by plastic can discolor and deteriorate fabric. Plastics to avoid include dry cleaning bags, heavy duty garbage bags, garment bags and ...

How to store quilts. To store quilts, avoid placing them in plastic bags or boxes, because that inhibits airflow around the fabric and can cause the fabric to deteriorate. The best way to store ...

Never store quilts with moth balls. Moth balls can actually do more damage than help. If a quilt is an antique or valuable wrap in archival tissue paper. Archival tissue paper can help neutralize acids or other things in the air ...

Storing Quilts: For storing small quilts, I actually hang them from skirt or pants hangers and place them in a closet. For larger quilts, I fold them and store them on shelves with a clean sheet covering them.

Store antique quilts in a cool, dry, and well-ventilated area away from direct sunlight. Avoid folding them to prevent creases and instead roll them in acid-free tissue paper. Keep them away from potential pests and ...
