

What will the EU do for South Sudan?

The EU will advocate for initiatives on the permanent constitution-making, strengthening the rule of law and access to justice. Respect for human rights and compliance with the International Humanitarian Law will be at the centre of these efforts. The Multiannual Indicative Programme (MIP) for South Sudan for 2021-2024 amounts to EUR208 million.

When did South Sudan become a member of the EU?

Following the referendum in January 2011, and the independence of the country in July of the same year, the EU substantially increased its development assistance and quickly established a fully-fledged Delegation to South Sudan in 2012.

What is the EU's goal for South Sudan?

The EU's overall objective is to achieve a more stable, resilient, and peaceful South Sudan, something that would benefit not only the country itself but the wider Horn of Africa region in general. By 2021, three priority areas were agreed on, based on the partnerships described in the EU comprehensive strategy with Africa.

Is South Sudan a developing country?

South Sudan is part of the group of Least Developed Countries. The development challenges for the newest country in the world are huge, aggravated by the legacies of war, frequent local violence and lack of modern infrastructures.

How many refugees are in South Sudan?

This includes 2 million internally displaced and nearly 2.3 million who are living as refugees in the neighboring countries. South Sudan is hosting more than 300,000 refugees. As of end of October, more than 350,000 people have been registered crossing the border from Sudan into South Sudan. Of them, 87% are South Sudanese returnees.

What does the Multiannual financing decision mean for South Sudan?

The multiannual financing decision, constituting the multiannual action plan in favour of the Republic of South Sudan for 2021-2022 has been adopted. The action plan includes the following actions: 'Peace, reconciliation and rule of law' and 'Integrated support to education in South Sudan in a context of people's displacements and returns'.

At least 7.1 million people living in South Sudan were estimated to have been severely food insecure at the peak of the lean season between July and September 2024. The situation is exacerbated by South Sudan's weak health system, further strained due to the influx of refugees and returnees from Sudan.
