The Gambia is entirely dependent on fossil fuel for electricity generation. The power network is principally owned and operated by the National Water and Electricity Company (NAWEC). The main power station at Kotu runs on heavy fuel oil (HFO) and in rural areas, NAWEC operates six small scale power systems served by stand-alone electricity subsystems in provincial centres.
