Where are solar panels located?

Usually, solar panels of a self-consumption system are located on the roof, although it is not the area closest to the storage system or energy meters. For security and architectural integration reasons, the roof of the buildings is usually determined as the location area for the solar panels.

Where should solar panels be placed in the UK?

The best spot for solar panels in the UK is a roof that faces south and has a tilt of about 35 degrees. But remember, these are just general guidelines. Other factors - like shading from your immediate environment and your specific location - could affect where your installer can place your solar panels.

Where should solar panels be installed?

To maximise the output of solar panels, you will want to have them installed on a south-facing section of your roof. South-facing solar panels in the UK receive the most sunlight exposure, as the sun is in the sky the most in this direction.

Which direction should solar panels go?

As a general rule, the optimal direction for solar panels in the northern hemisphere is south. And in the southern hemisphere, the direction is north. So, the optimal direction for solar panels in the entire United States is south. The optimal tilt angle for fixed solar panels, as per a rule of thumb, is equal to the latitude of your location.

Which direction should solar panels face in the UK?

In the UK, solar panels should ideally face south in order to capture the most daylight throughout the day. It's best to avoid installing solar panels that face north, since there's never much daylight from that direction in the northern hemisphere. Panels can still perform well facing east or west.
